# Waste Management in the Mt Buller and Mt Stirling Alpine Resort

## What can I recycle?

You can recycle any plastic, glass, aluminium, steel, paper and cardboard simply by putting it in a clear recycling bag. Organic food waste can also be recycled in a separate bag.

### ✓ DO

- Put all garbage in black garbage bags.
- Put all recyclables in clear plastic recycling bags available from garbage huts. (Keep food waste separate).
- Tie and secure knot in the top of each garbage bag when full.
- Take full garbage or recycling bags to the nearest garbage hut (see map on reverse).
- Clean up any mess you make.
- Close the door when you leave to prevent animal access and contain odours.

### ✗ DON'T

- Don't overload garbage or recycling bags.
- Don't put garbage in recycling bags.
- Don't leave hard waste, building waste, automotive parts, furniture or chemicals in the garbage hut.
- Don't block the doorway in garbage huts.

## 'The Living Bin' organic recycling

Did you know that food waste comprises 50% of all waste in Alpine Resorts.

By collecting food waste we have increased our recycling levels to over 40%. You can help create organic soil by placing your organic waste in the bags and bins provided.

### ✓ What you can put into the organic bin:

- All organic/living food scraps.
- Fruit and vegetables.

### ✗ What you cannot put into the organics bin:

- NO plastics! This includes glad wrap, plastic containers, sauce sachets, straws, plastic forks & knives.
- No metals including foil.
- No broken glass or crockery.
- No nappies.

## What happens next?

Recycling and food waste organics bags are collected from the garbage huts in one truck and taken to Boggy Corner Recycling Depot. General waste is collected in a second truck and taken to Boggy Corner Recycling Depot. The collected bags are then separated and distributed to appropriate waste and recycling centres.

## Where do I get Recycling and Food Waste Organics bags?

Recycling bags are provided free of charge by the Mt Buller Resort Management Board. They are available in the garbage huts.
