

DOG PERMIT CONDITIONS

Dog Permit Holders must:

- Comply with the Animal Policy and Permit Conditions.
- Demonstrate responsible dog ownership and make sure anyone walking the dog complies with the Animal Policy and Permit Conditions.
- Support efforts to build community awareness and understanding of the Policy and Permit Conditions.
- Report non-compliances so the Board can act to build community awareness and compliance.
- Respect the obligations of the Board and staff to implement the Policy, comply with relevant legislation and regulation and take enforcement action where necessary.

Dogs must:

- Be on a lead at all times when outdoors.
- Not be left tied up or unattended in public spaces.
- Wear their Mt Buller registration tag (so it is visible) at all times.
- Not be taken on resort transport (carpark shuttles, village shuttles, rideshare vehicles)

When walking a dog, you must:

- Present the dogs registration tag upon request from an Authorised person.
- Provide your name and address upon request from an Authorised person.
- Have effective control of the dog at all times.
- Avoid danger or unreasonable disturbance to other persons, wildlife or property.
- Always carry a dog waste bag, clean up after your dog, tie the bag, and place it in one of the dog waste bins provided outside the rubbish huts
- Only walk dogs in permitted walking areas and not take dogs into public buildings including Alpine Central.

Permitted Dog Walking Areas:

- Dogs can be walked at all times in the areas shown in green below
- Dogs can also be walked in the areas shown in orange below:
 - In the Village Square other than when a public event is underway and between 8am and 6pm during the Declared Snow Season.
 - Across the following ski runs when the ski lifts or snow groomers are not operating:
 - Bourke Street Ski Run crossover between ABOM Restaurant & ABOM Express Chairlift
 - Chamois Ski Run crossover on Family Trail cross country track

DOG WALKING MAP



Year-round designated areas for dogs with a valid permit are marked on the map below. Dogs are only allowed in the areas identified on this map. They are not permitted anywhere else within the ski area or on the resort trails. Permit holders must comply with the Animal Policy and Permit Conditions at all times available at www.rmb.mtbuller.com.au/permits-licenses.

DOG WALKING ZONE

Dogs can be walked at all times in the areas shown in green below.

RESTRICTED DOG WALKING ZONE

Dogs can also be walked in the areas shown in orange below:

- In the Village Square other than when a public event is underway and between 8am and 6pm during the Declared Snow Season.
- Across the following ski runs when the ski lifts or snow groomers are not operating:
 - Bourke Street Ski Run crossover between ABOM Restaurant & ABOM Express Chairlift
 - Chamois Ski Run crossover on Family Trail cross country track

PLEASE NOTE:

- Valid Mt Buller registration tag must be visible.
- Dogs must be on a lead, attended and under control at all times.
- Always carry a dog waste bag, clean up after your dog, tie the bag and place in dog waste bins located outside the rubbish huts.
- Dogs not permitted:
 - Athletes Walk
 - On resort transport (carpark shuttles, village shuttles, rideshare vehicles)
 - In public buildings including Alpine Central & Village Square Plaza
 - Anywhere else within the Mt Buller Resort
